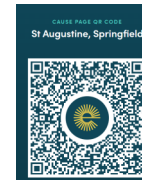

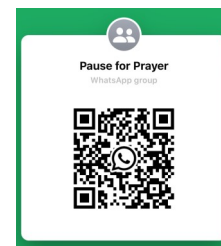

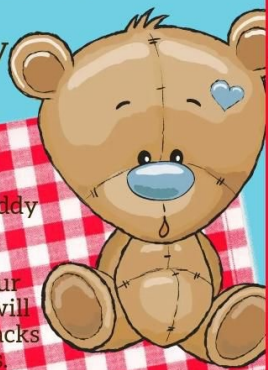

Prayer for Our Church during the Interregnum

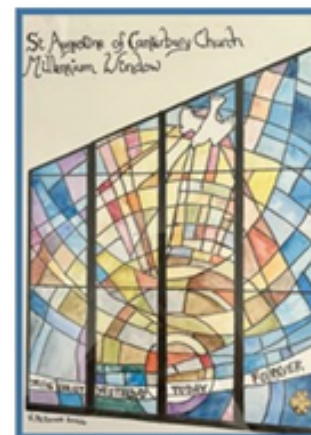
Heavenly Father,

and faithfulness in prayer.

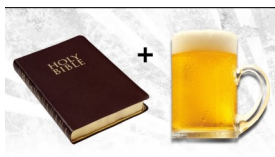
Guide with your heavenly wisdom the one whom
