


Contactless payments can be taken with our new card reader.- all you have to do is chose the amount you want to give and zap your credit card. The Welcome team will have this available before and after services. If you are

Chelmsford for this purpose


This year the free lecture series exploring the connection between Anglicanism and its rich musical traditions.
